Allowances	Rate
Expenses reimbursement	reimbursement for work-related expenses
Mobile phone reimbursement - a mobile phone on plan	Reimbursement of at least 50% of the cost of the employee's monthly phone plan (for a maximum monthly phone plan of \$100)
Mobile phone reimbursement - a pre-paid mobile phone	Reimbursement of a reasonable amount agreed to in writing by the employer and employee
Motorcycle allowance	\$0.26 per km up to a maximum of 400 kms per week
Stand-by and call-out allowance - strata / community title management or property management classifications only	a method of payment agreed in writing between the employee and employer for due compensation for the employee being on stand-by and/or call-out

Motor vehicle allowances

Where an employee is required to use their own motor vehicle in the course of their employment, they can be reimbursed by:

- Payment of a standing charge plus an amount per kilometre travelled in performing their duties, or
- Payment of a lump sum, or
- \$0.78 per kilometre to a maximum of 400km per week
